
Seeded by NERA and UON in 2021 as part of H2TCA.

NewH2 is part of a nationwide hydrogen cluster network to foster a multi-billion dollar, globally competitive hydrogen technology industry for Australia. NewH2 has established to industry cluster initiatives that:

- facilitate **connections** and **knowledge sharing** and by bringing together the expertise, technologies, resources, capital and knowledge of businesses and organisations
- support the development and coordination of hydrogen supply chains and innovation
 - **identify gaps** and **barriers**, to support the region to be equipped with the **skills required** for the development, deployment and commercialisation of new hydrogen focused technologies.



The founding principles of NewH2 is a model of open access and 2-way engagement



In 2022-25 the focus is to further mature the cluster to meet market needs including the support of large scale project and support the delivery of Hunter Roadmap elements
